## News Brief

### Summer Exploration Drilling Program

Generation PGM Inc. (GenPGM) has started an 8,000metre summer exploration drilling program on the Marathon Palladium-Copper Project. This drill program is an addition to the 2,000m program recently completed this winter.

Drilling recommenced on May 15, 2021 once the spring thaw had subsided. The first phase of drilling this summer contains 4,000m of drilling focused on 7 drill holes in the Central Feeder Zone area. This zone resides on the western boundary of the Marathon Palladium-Copper deposit. The Company reported multiple high-grade intercepts in this area from the winter drill program completed in April 2021, and looks forward to the further exploring the potential in the area.

Once the 7 holes in the Central Feeder Zone are complete, the drill will be moved to the Chonolith Zone which is located north of the Marathon Palladium-Copper deposit. There will be 8 to 10 holes in this area to target an irregular to pipe shaped intrusion at depth that hosts potential for focused magma flow and massive sulphide accumulation.

In addition to the drill program, a surface exploration crew are actively mapping the area between the Sally Deposit and Boyer Prospect, a 2.5km long portion of the property that has not been systematically mapped or prospected.
